Research Analysis

The committee substitute for HB 2411, adds the National Interpreter Certification (NIC) to the list of certifications necessary to be a qualified legal interpreter. The measure allows for court reporters that are able to provide real time captioning to serve as a qualified legal interpreter if no person meeting the outlined qualifications is available. The measure states that the court is not required to provide an interpreter for attorney-client communications which are not immediately pertaining to the court proceeding nor for meetings at the private counsel's office.
