Research Analysis

HB 3104 provides that in a civil action in which a person's rights to carry a firearm have been violated due to an order, policy, ordinance, or other regulation promulgated or enforced by any person, municipality, agency, or other political subdivision, the court may require the person, municipality, agency or political subdivision to pay reasonable expenses to the aggrieved party if the aggrieved party had provided written notice of the unlawful action by certified first-class mail or service of process and allowed the entity 90 days to abrogate the action.
