**Research Analysis**

HB 3914, as introduced, places restrictions on social media usage. Social media companies may not allow minors under 16 to use social media and must require parental consent for minors 16 or older. Companies who violate this regulation are subject to a \$2,500 fine per violation plus court costs, attorney fees, and damages. The Attorney General is also authorized to take legal action. Additionally, commercial entities are prohibited from retaining user information once the user is granted access to the social media platform.
