**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3930 would require all state government entities to install at least one facility with a publicly accessible restroom with a bidet that meets the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act. The Office of Management and Enterprise Services (OMES) has provided the following cost breakdown of a bidet installation for various scenarios that may arise with the implementation of this measure:

| <b>Restroom Type</b>  | <b>Cost Range</b>    |
|---|----------------------|
| Current ADA compliant accessible restroom   | \$20,000 - \$30,000  |
| Current ADA compliant accessible restroom that would no longer be compliant without additional renovation | \$50,000 - \$60,000  |
| Non-ADA complaint accessible restroom (may include buildings constructed or renovated pre-1990)           | \$50,000 - \$160,000 |

OMES does state that if this measure would allow for the option of an integrated toilet and bidet unit, the cost range for installation would potentially decrease by Six to Ten Thousand dollars (\$6,000 - \$10,000) if only minimal renovation is required.
