Research Analysis

The floor amendment for HB 4073 names the measure Alyssa's Law, specifies that the alert system will be a mobile panic alert system, and designates funds to implement the systems.

HB 4073, as amended, requires public school districts to implement mobile panic alert systems from a State Board of Education-approved list. Funding for the systems will come from the School Security Revolving Fund. Every system should be capable of the following:

- Connecting emergency service technologies among first responder agencies;
- Transmitting 911 calls and mobile activations;
- Automatically alerting school personnel when an emergency response is initiated on-site by a phone application, phone call, text message, or other technology;
- Providing emergency responders with floor plans and caller location; and
- Integrating school personnel with emergency responders to provide updates during an emergency.
