**Bill Analysis**

The CS for SB 1048 directs that funding from SB 1040 appropriated to the Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services be spent in the following manner:

- 1) \$2,621,853.00 shall be expended on program growth
- 2) \$2,017,579.00 shall be used to replace funding no longer available due to the reduction of federal matching dollars
- 3) \$7 million shall be spent on targeted provider rate increases
- 4) \$2 million shall be used to increase funding for services for children with acute behavioral health issues
- 5) \$700,000.00 shall be used to expand services for veterans and their families
- 6) \$3.5 million shall be used to expand the number of beds at the Oklahoma Forensic Center located in Vinita, Oklahoma
- 7) \$1 million shall be used to expand the family treatment court program
- 8) \$500,000.00 shall be used to maintain five pilot programs to provide offenders incarcerated in county jails in the State of Oklahoma access to United States Food and Drug Administration-approved, evidence-based, medication assisted treatment for opioid and alcohol dependence
