**Bill Analysis**

SB 110 increases the maximum term of imprisonment from 3 years to 10 years and the maximum fine from \$3,000.00 to \$5,000.00 for persons convicted of assault and battery with intent to cause great bodily harm by strangulation or attempted strangulation against an intimate partner or a family or household member for the first violation. The measure also increases the maximum term of imprisonment for a second or subsequent violations from 10 to 20 years.
