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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1238 modifies language relating to the school day, clarifying that a student who transfers from his or her resident district to another school district pursuant to the Education Open Transfer Act is able to enroll in a full-time virtual education program offered by the receiving district. It requires a board of education of a district with a full-time virtual education program to adopt a policy to determine the number of transfer students the program has the capacity to accept in each grade level. The bill removes language that prohibits a school district from offering full-time virtual education to students who are not residents of the district.

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
