**Bill Analysis**

SB 1367 increases the administrative penalty for persons who intentionally or improperly divert medical marijuana from \$200.00 to not less than \$400.00 for the first offense and from \$500.00 to not less than \$1,000.00 for the second offense. Persons or entities who are found to have improperly diverted medical marijuana after the 2nd offense shall also be subject to license revocation and may result in owners or person with an interest in the offending entity shall also be subject to license revocation. Additionally, the measure increases the fines for sales or transfers of medical marijuana to unauthorized persons to \$5,000.00 for the first violation and \$15,000.00 for subsequent violations.

**House Amendments**

HA's to the measure add language relating to increasing fines for the sale or transfer of medical marijuana to unauthorized persons.
