**Bill Analysis**

SB 1675 extends the deadline for the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to implement provisions of law relating to capitated contracts from October 1, 2023, to April 1, 2024. The measure also requires all contracted entities to complete credentialing or recredentialing of a provider within 60 calendar days of receipt of a completed application. The measure also modifies the time a contracted entity has to deliver a request for services for a hospitalized member from 1 business day to 24 hours and sets a 24-hour requirement for peer-to-peer conversations following an adverse determination. The measure establishes a 3% limit on the percentage of claims subject to postpayment audits and broadens provisions regarding denied claims to cover downgraded claims. The measure also extends the duration of the minimum rates of reimbursement established by the Authority from July 1, 2026, to July 1, 2027. Additionally, the measure requires at least 1 capitated contract to provide statewide coverage to Medicaid members to be awarded to a provider-owned entity that submitted a responsive reply to the Authority's request for proposals demonstrating ability to fulfill the contract requirements.

**CCR Changes**

The Conference Committee Report for SB 1675 adds language relating to awarding at least 1 capitated contract to a provider-owned entity.
