**Research Analysis**

The second floor amendment to SB 1737 removes the specification that the required signage be posted at each entrance and in a conspicuous location. Instead, the required signage must be posted at the perimeter of the property in a size large enough to be viewable from the appropriate easements or public roadway. The amendment also allows for 60 days after the renewal of each application for a grow license before the license is revoked for lack of signage.
