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**Bill Analysis**

SB 1758 provides that the Oklahoma Health Care Authority shall serve as the state administering agency responsible for administering programs of all-inclusive care for the elderly (PACE). The Authority shall be responsible for enforcing the federal regulations of the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services governing PACE. The measure provides that PACE organizations shall be exempt from licensure by the State Department of Health under the Home Care Act, the Adult Day Care Act, or any other act that governs a different type of facility or provider.

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
