Bill Analysis

SB 1917 prohibits any insurer from cancelling a homeowner policy solely because the owner filed a claim arising from a weather-related catastrophe or a major natural disaster as declared by the Governor. Insurers are also prohibited from cancelling a homeowner policy solely because the owner has a history of such claims. The measure requires an insurer cancelling a homeowner policy mid-term to provide written notice of the cancellation to the owner 30 days prior to the cancellation.
