## **Bill Analysis**

SB 762 requires all intrastate processors to have a Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry inspector on site, a contract Department-certified inspector on site, or remote technologies that allow inspection during the slaughter, processing, and butchering of cattle or bison. The measure provides for cooperative agreements between counties, municipalities, extension services, intrastate processors, and/or livestock producers to pay the costs of retaining contract Department-certified inspectors. The measure outlines the requirements for inspectors utilizing on site or remote technology inspections. Live feeds, as it relates to technology inspections, must provide the inspector with appropriate viewing angels, high resolution, and lighting to spot illness or injury and to ensure compliance with slaughtering standards. Packaging for intrastate processors must have an attached label prominently displayed that states: "Inspected by ODAFF only for sale in Oklahoma."
