Bill Analysis

SB 902 requires any plaintiff filing for the dismissal of a protective order relating to domestic abuse to present to the court a safety plan specific to the plaintiff. The plan shall include code words that may be used to covertly alert a designated person that the plaintiff needs assistance, contact information for individuals that can support or assist the plaintiff as well as individuals the plaintiff can sure location information, a safe place, a list of items needed if he or she is forced to leave his or her residence unexpectedly, contact information for a domestic violence shelter or organization, and other information as needed.
