**Research Analysis**

SB 968 directs a law enforcement agency to deny access to any audio or video recording that depicts the death of a law enforcement officer who was acting in the course of his or her official duties. The video may be released if the court finds that the public interest or the interest of an individual outweighs the reason for denial. Family members of the deceased officer may view the audio or video of the officer's death. Prosecutors and defense attorney's retain the right to use such videos as evidence in a legal proceeding.
