12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1461 of Title 25, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. It is an unlawful discriminatory practice for:
17	1. The state or any of its political subdivisions or any entity
18	receiving state funding in any form, including grants and property
19	tax exemptions, to refuse, withhold from, or deny to a person any
20	local, state, or federal funds, services, goods, facilities,
21	advantages, privileges, licensing, educational opportunities, health
22	care access or employment opportunities based on a person's
23	vaccination status;

- 2. An employer to refuse employment to a person, to bar a person from employment, or to discriminate against a person in compensation or in a term, condition, or privilege of employment based on the person's vaccination status;
- 3. A public accommodation to exclude, limit, refuse to serve, or otherwise discriminate against an individual based on the individual's vaccination status; or
- 4. An entity listed in this subsection to implement an immunity passport system.
- B. An entity governed by subsection A of this section shall not unlawfully discriminate as long as any vaccination policy set forth includes exemptions for individuals to decline to be vaccinated based on medical or religious grounds.
 - C. As used in this section:
- 1. "Immunity passport" means a document, digital record, or software application indicating that a person is immune to a disease, either through vaccination or infection and recovery; and
- 2. "Vaccination status" means an indication of whether a person has received one or more doses of a vaccine.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2022.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
