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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 13 O.S. 2011, Section 176.7, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 176.7 The Attorney General, upon application by a
19	district attorney, may make application to a judge of competent
20	jurisdiction for, and such judge may grant in conformity with the
21	Security of Communications Act, an order authorizing the
22	interception of wire, oral or electronic communications by any law
23	enforcement agency of this state or any political subdivision
24	thereof having responsibility for the investigation of the offense

1	as to which the application is made, when such interception may
2	provide evidence of acts of biochemical terrorism, terrorism,
3	terrorism hoax, and biochemical assault, as defined in Section
4	1268.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the commission of the
5	offense of murder, the cultivation or manufacture or distribution of
6	narcotic drugs or other controlled dangerous substances, as defined
7	in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, <del>or</del> trafficking
8	in illegal drugs, as defined in the Trafficking in Illegal Drugs
9	Act, the trafficking of humans for labor or for commercial sex, as
10	defined in Section 748 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
11	pandering of humans for sex as provided in Section 1081 of Title 21
12	of the Oklahoma Statutes or the prostitution of a child, as defined
13	in Section 1030 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and any
14	conspiracy to commit the crimes specifically enumerated in this
15	section.
16	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
