8 An Act relating to common carriers; amending 13 O.S.
9 2011, Section 176.7, which relates to the Security of
10 Communications Act; adding certain offenses for which
11 an order of interception may be obtained; and
12 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 13 O.S. 2011, Section 176.7, is
15 amended to read as follows:

16 Section 176.7 The Attorney General, upon application by a
17 district attorney, may make application to a judge of competent
18 jurisdiction for, and such judge may grant in conformity with the
19 Security of Communications Act, an order authorizing the
20 interception of wire, oral or electronic communications by any law
21 enforcement agency of this state or any political subdivision
22 thereof having responsibility for the investigation of the offense
23 as to which the application is made, when such interception may
24 provide evidence of acts of biochemical terrorism, terrorism,

1 terrorism hoax, and biochemical assault, as defined in Section
2 1268.1 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the commission of the
3 offense of murder, the cultivation or manufacture or distribution of
4 narcotic drugs or other controlled dangerous substances, as defined
5 in the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act, ~~or~~ trafficking
6 in illegal drugs, as defined in the Trafficking in Illegal Drugs
7 Act, the trafficking of humans for labor or for commercial sex, as
8 defined in Section 748 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the
9 pandering of humans for sex as provided in Section 1081 of Title 21
10 of the Oklahoma Statutes or the prostitution of a child, as defined
11 in Section 1030 of Title 21 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and any
12 conspiracy to commit the crimes specifically enumerated in this
13 section.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
