8 An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of
9 Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; requiring that
10 portions of certain funds be utilized for certain
11 purposes; providing budgeting and expenditure
12 limitations and procedures; and providing for lapse
13 of funds under certain conditions.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
16 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
17 No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma
18 Legislature, the sum of Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000.00) shall,
19 under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated
20 to wildland fire response resources.

21 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
22 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
23 No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma
24 Legislature, the sum of Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) shall,

1 under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated
2 to advancing leadership in agricultural businesses.

3 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
4 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
5 No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma
6 Legislature, the sum of Six Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand
7 Dollars (\$6,950,000.00) shall, under the direction of the
8 Commissioner of Agriculture, be allocated to rural fire departments
9 for replacement of equipment and gear burned during fires including
10 truck chassis.

11 SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
12 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
13 No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma
14 Legislature, the sum of One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00)
15 shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of Agriculture, be
16 allocated to rural fire coordinators to administer a wet hydrant
17 program.

18 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma
19 Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill
20 No. 1004 of the 1st Extraordinary Session of the 59th Oklahoma
21 Legislature, the sum of Two Million One Hundred Thousand Dollars
22 (\$2,100,000.00) shall, under the direction of the Commissioner of
23 Agriculture, be used for providing grants to incorporated
24 municipalities affected by the extreme weather event that began

1 February 7, 2021, and ended February 21, 2021, as provided for in
2 Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1091 of the 2nd Session of the 58th
3 Oklahoma Legislature.

4 SECTION 6. Appropriations made by this act, not including
5 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for
6 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24) or may be
7 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025 (hereafter FY-25).
8 Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 30,
9 2024, and must be expended by November 15, 2024. Any funds
10 remaining after November 15, 2024, and not budgeted for FY-25, shall
11 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal
12 year. Funds budgeted for FY-25 may be encumbered only through June
13 30, 2025. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2025, shall lapse
14 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.
15 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years
16 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-24, and not required to pay
17 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-25, after
18 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared
19 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds
20 from the FY-24 budget work program and after such revision has been
21 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.
