12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified								
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3611 of Title 63, unless there								
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:								
15	In situations in which the state requires a drug test to be								
16	performed on an individual, the test shall be performed through a								
17	multi-testing evaluation process by using urinalysis, nail bed, hair								
18	follicle, and sweat test using a 20-panel rather than a 10-panel								
19	drug test to ensure the drug abuser is substance free. The multi-								
20	testing evaluation process shall be accompanied by a rapid DNA test								
21	of the sample to ensure the sample given belongs to the individual								
22	being tested.
