9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the Department of Transportation;  
11 authorizing certain expenditures for certain  
12 purposes; stating purpose; directing certain  
13 expenditures; requiring transfers of certain monies;  
14 providing for duties and compensation of employees;  
15 authorizing the Department to match certain federal  
16 funds and coordinate with the Oklahoma Department of  
17 Emergency Management for expenditure of funds;  
18 authorizing expenditure of certain funds in  
19 conjunction or cooperation with federal agencies or  
20 instrumentalities; making certain appropriations  
21 nonfiscal; providing lapse dates; requiring certain  
22 budget procedures; prohibiting certain budget  
23 procedures; and providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. The Department of Transportation is hereby  
22 authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018,  
23 from the State Transportation Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of  
24 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary

1 to perform the duties imposed upon the Department of Transportation  
2 by law. Said authorization shall be transferred to the State  
3 Highway Construction and Maintenance Fund and shall be expended in  
4 the same manner and for the same purposes as provided by law for  
5 other monies accruing to the credit of the State Highway  
6 Construction and Maintenance Fund.

7 SECTION 2. The Department of Transportation shall expend from  
8 the funds dedicated to construction not less than \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
9 (\$0.00) for the construction of roads to existing industrial sites  
10 and roads for economic development purposes, and not less than  
11 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) for the construction, maintenance and repair  
12 of roads to historical sites and lake access roads.

13 SECTION 3. TRANSFER The Director of the Office of  
14 Management and Enterprise Services shall transfer the sum of  
15 \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$0.00) from the State Highway Construction and  
16 Maintenance Fund to the Public Transit Revolving Fund of the State  
17 Treasury. These funds shall be expended in the same manner and for  
18 the same purposes as provided by law for other monies accruing to  
19 the credit of the Public Transit Revolving Fund.

20 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
21 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
22 upon the Department of Transportation by law shall be set by the  
23 Director of the Department of Transportation. The Department of  
24 Transportation for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018, shall be

1 subject to the following budgetary limitations on full-time-  
2 equivalent employees and expenditures excluding expenditures for  
3 capital and special projects, except as may be authorized pursuant  
4 to the provisions of Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma  
5 Statutes:

9 SECTION 5. The Department of Transportation is hereby  
10 authorized to use any funds available to the Department to match  
11 funds which are advanced under the provisions of Sections 402, 403  
12 and 419, P.L. 93-288, Disaster Relief Act of 1974, to repair,  
13 restore, reconstruct or replace public transportation facilities or  
14 to remove debris or wreckage from publicly owned facilities. The  
15 Department of Transportation shall coordinate with the Oklahoma  
16 Department of Emergency Management for expenditure of funds for such  
17 purpose.

18 SECTION 6. All funds available by law for expenditure by the  
19 Department of Transportation may be used and expended in conjunction  
20 or cooperation with any federal agency or instrumentality pursuant  
21 to such terms and conditions as may be necessary to obtain grants or  
22 federal aid assistance in accordance with state law.

23 SECTION 7. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
24 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2018 (hereafter FY-18) or may be  
2 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019 (hereafter FY-19).  
3 Funds budgeted for FY-18 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
4 2018, and must be expended by November 15, 2018. Any funds  
5 remaining after November 15, 2018, and not budgeted for FY-19, shall  
6 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
7 year. Funds budgeted for FY-19 may be encumbered only through June  
8 30, 2019. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2019, shall lapse  
9 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
10 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
11 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-18, and not required to pay  
12 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-19, after  
13 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
14 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds  
15 from the FY-18 budget work program and after such revision has been  
16 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

17 SECTION 8. This act shall become effective July 1, 2017.

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
