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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 265, O.S.L.
16	2012 (63 O.S. Supp. 2014, Section 1-1925.4), is amended to read as
17	follows:
18	Section 1-1925.4 A. Upon admittance into the facility, nursing
19	facilities and specialized facilities that do not have emergency
20	power generators available or a written disaster plan on file during
21	an emergency situation shall provide a written disclosure to any
22	resident or resident's caregiver stating that the facility does not
23	have either a generator available or a written disaster plan on file
24	during an emergency situation All nursing facilities that provide

1 services to individuals shall be required to have an emergency plan, 2 which includes having an emergency power generator available on- or 3 off-site.

B. All nursing facilities, assisted living centers, residential
care homes and specialized facilities shall have an emergency
evacuation plan in place. Such plan shall be coordinated and on
file at the local emergency management agency. Such plan shall also
be filed with the State Department of Health.

9 C. For purposes of this section, "assisted living center" shall 10 have the same meaning as specified in Section 1-890.2 of Title 63 of 11 the Oklahoma Statutes this title, and "nursing facility", 12 "residential care home" and "specialized facility" shall have the 13 same meaning as specified in Section 1-1902 of Title 63 of the 14 Oklahoma Statutes this title.

D. The State Board of Health may promulgate rules as necessary
to implement the provisions of this section, including, but not
limited to, requirements for disclosure and enforcement.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.

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
