12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 46 O.S. 2011, Section 15, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 15. A. Any mortgage on real estate shall be released
16	by the holder of any such mortgage within <del>fifty (50)</del> thirty (30)
17	days of the payment of the debt secured by the mortgage and the
18	holder of the mortgage shall file the release of the mortgage with
19	the county clerk where the mortgage is recorded. If, at the end of
20	the <del>fifty-day</del> thirty-day period, the holder has failed to release
21	the mortgage, the mortgagor may at any time request in writing the
22	holder of the mortgage to release the mortgage and the holder of the
23	mortgage shall have ten (10) days from the date of the request to
24	release such mortgage. If the holder of the mortgage fails to

1 release the mortgage by the end of such ten-day period, he the 2 mortgage holder shall then forfeit and pay to the mortgagor a penalty of one percent (1%) of the principal debt not to exceed One 3 4 Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per day each day the release is not 5 recorded after the ten-day period has expired and the penalty shall be recovered in a civil action in any court having jurisdiction 6 7 thereof, but the request for the release shall be in writing and 8 describe the mortgage and premises with reasonable certainty. 9 Provided that, the total penalty shall not exceed one hundred 10 percent (100%) of the total principal debt. 11 B. For purposes of this section, "mortgagor" shall include any 12 subsequent purchaser of the mortgaged real estate. 13 SECTION 2.
