9 AS INTRODUCED

10 An Act relating to the State Auditor and Inspector;  
11 making appropriations; stating purposes; providing  
12 certain appropriations shall not be transferable;  
13 requiring budgeting in certain categories and  
14 amounts; providing for duties and compensation of  
15 employees; providing budgetary limitations; making  
16 certain appropriations nonfiscal; providing lapse  
17 dates; requiring certain budget procedures;  
18 prohibiting certain budget procedures; and providing  
19 an effective date.

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24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the  
State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise  
appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
(\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
imposed upon the State Auditor and Inspector by law.

1 SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Office of the  
 2 State Auditor and Inspector from any monies not otherwise  
 3 appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for  
 4 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars  
 5 (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties  
 6 imposed upon the Commission on County Government Personnel Education  
 7 and Training. The appropriation made in this section shall be  
 8 expended exclusively for the purpose so stated and shall not be  
 9 transferable.

10 SECTION 3. For the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, the State  
 11 Auditor and Inspector shall budget all funds in the following  
 12 categories and amounts:

21 SECTION 4. The duties and compensation of employees, not  
 22 otherwise prescribed by law, necessary to perform the duties imposed  
 23 upon the State Auditor and Inspector by law shall be set by the  
 24 State Auditor and Inspector. The State Auditor and Inspector for

1 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016, shall be subject to the  
2 following budgetary limitations on full-time-equivalent employees  
3 and expenditures excluding expenditures for capital and special  
4 projects, except as may be authorized pursuant to the provisions of  
5 Section 3603 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes:

9 SECTION 5. Appropriations made by this act, not including  
10 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for  
11 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016 (hereafter FY-16) or may be  
12 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2017 (hereafter FY-17).  
13 Funds budgeted for FY-16 may be encumbered only through June 30,  
14 2016, and must be expended by November 15, 2016. Any funds  
15 remaining after November 15, 2016, and not budgeted for FY-17, shall  
16 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal  
17 year. Funds budgeted for FY-17 may be encumbered only through June  
18 30, 2017. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2017, shall lapse  
19 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year.  
20 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years  
21 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-16, and not required to pay  
22 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-17, after  
23 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared  
24 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds

1 from the FY-16 budget work program and after such revision has been  
2 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services.

3 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.

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
