| 18 | A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Disabled |
| 19 | Veteran Business Enterprise Act". |

| 21 | 1. "Service-disabled veteran" means any individual that is |
| 22 | disabled as certified by the appropriate federal agency responsible |
| 23 | for the administration of veterans' affairs. |
| 24 | 2 "Sarvice-disabled veteran business" means a business. |

- not less than fifty-one percent (51%) of which is owned by one or more service-disabled veterans or, in the case of any publicly owned business, not less than fifty-one percent (51%) of the stock of which is owned by one or more service-disabled veterans, and
- the management and daily business operations of which are controlled by one or more service-disabled
- service, all agencies, departments, institutions and other entities of this state and of each political subdivision of this state shall give a three-point bonus preference to service-disabled veteran businesses doing business as Oklahoma firms, corporations or individuals, or which maintain Oklahoma offices or places of business.
- D. In implementing the provisions of subsection C of this section, the following shall apply:
- The Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise Services shall have the goal of three percent (3%) of all such contracts described in subsection C of this section to be awarded to such veterans;
- 2. If an insufficient number of such veterans doing business in this state submit a bid or proposal for a contract by an agency, department, institution or other entity of the state or a political
