7 An Act relating to public finance; prohibiting state
8 or local government entities from entering into
9 certain agreements; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 10001 of Title 62, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 No state governmental entity and no county, city, town, public
18 trust having the state or any county, city or town as its
19 beneficiary or beneficiaries, whether one or more beneficiary
20 entities of any combination, may enter into any agreement with a
21 person, partnership, limited partnership, limited liability
22 partnership, corporation, limited liability company, trust or other
23 legal entity that would prohibit the governmental entity from making
24 full disclosure of the terms of any agreement with such entity to

1 make payment to or confer value upon the entity using an incentive,
2 tax credit, direct or indirect payment, grant, or similar benefit
3 offered to such entity if the benefit is provided through the use of
4 state or local taxes.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
