8 An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S.
9 2021, Section 14-120.2, as amended by Section 15,
10 Chapter 116, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section
11 14-120.2), which relates to law enforcement escort;
12 modifying responsible entity; and providing an
13 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2021, Section 14-120.2, as
17 amended by Section 15, Chapter 116, O.S.L. 2022 (47 O.S. Supp. 2022,
18 Section 14-120.2), is amended to read as follows:

19 Section 14-120.2 A. Every person required by the Department of
20 Transportation, the Oklahoma Turnpike Authority, or any federal
21 agency or commission to have a law enforcement escort provided by
22 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol Division of the Department of Public
23 Safety for the transport of any oversized load or hazardous shipment
24 by road or rail shall pay to the Department of ~~Transportation~~ Public

1 Safety a fee covering the full cost to administer, plan, and carry
2 out the escort within this state.

3 B. If the Highway Patrol provides an escort to accompany the
4 transport of an oversized load or hazardous shipment by road or rail
5 at the request of any person that is not required to have a law
6 enforcement escort pursuant to subsection A of this section, then
7 the requestor shall pay to the Department of ~~Transportation~~ Public
8 Safety a fee covering the full cost to administer, plan, and carry
9 out the escort within this state.

10 C. The Department of ~~Transportation~~ Public Safety shall adopt a
11 schedule of fees necessary to implement this section.

12 D. All fees collected by the Department of ~~Transportation~~
13 Public Safety pursuant to this section shall be deposited to the
14 credit of the ~~State Transportation~~ Department of Public Safety
15 Revolving Fund established pursuant to Section ~~1501.1~~ 2-144.1 of
16 ~~Title 69 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
