If electors approve the issuing of bonds at an election, the 3 Β. 4 school district shall continue to post on its website the bond 5 information required by subsection A of this section for the duration of the bond and one year after completion of all bond 6 7 projects. The information posted on the school district website shall also include updates when there is a material change in the 8 9 scope of the projects and their purpose as stated at the time the 10 board of education calls the bond election. The updated information 11 shall be posted online within thirty (30) days following approval of 12 the project changes by the board of education.

C. This act shall not apply to any bond projects approved byelectors prior to the effective date of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
