12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2021, Section 1-1201, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 1-1201. (a) A. It shall be unlawful for any person to
16	operate or maintain a hotel unless he <u>or she</u> shall have first
17	obtained, and holds, a license issued for such purpose by the State
18	Commissioner of Health. Unless otherwise provided by rule by the
19	State Board of Health Commissioner, each such license shall expire
20	on the 30th day of June next following its issuance, and the
21	Commissioner shall charge and collect therefor an annual fee to be
22	fixed by the Board of Health <u>Commissioner</u> . The term "hotel" as used
23	in this section shall mean and include any hotel, motel, tourist
24	court, apartment house, rooming house, or other place where sleeping

accommodations are furnished, or offered, for pay for transient
 guests, if <u>four seven</u> or more rooms are available therein for
 transient guests. This section shall apply to the operation of a
 hotel by a state board.

5 (b) B. The State Board of Health Commissioner may adopt reasonable standards, rules and regulations for hotels as to the 6 7 following: buildings and appurtenances thereto, including plumbing, 8 ventilation and lighting; construction, cleanliness and bactericidal 9 treatment of equipment and utensils; cleanliness and hygiene of 10 personnel; toilet facilities; disposal of wastes; water supply; and 11 any other items deemed necessary to safeguard the health, comfort 12 and safety of guests accommodated therein.

13 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
