10	the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System; providing for offset of increase based upon certain
11	statutory provision; authorizing retirement benefit increase for certain members of the Uniform

20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
21	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 49-143.7 of Title 11, unless
23	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section and
except for persons receiving benefits pursuant to Section 49-101 of
Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes, effective July 1, 2015, any
person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Firefighters Pension and
Retirement System as of June 30, 2014, who continues to receive
benefits on or after July 1, 2015, shall receive a two-percent
increase in said benefits on July 1, 2015.

B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive
pursuant to repealed Section 49-136 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma
Statutes after June 30, 2008, shall be used to offset the increase
in benefits provided in subsection A of this section.

12 C. Effective July 1, 2015, any person receiving benefits 13 pursuant to Section 49-101 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes 14 shall each receive a benefit equal to Seven Dollars and sixty-eight 15 cents (\$7.68) for each year of credited service not to exceed thirty 16 (30) years of service.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 50-136.9 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Police Pension and Retirement System as of June 30, 2014, who continues to receive benefits on or after July 1, 2015, shall receive a two-percent increase in said benefits on July 1, 2015.

B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive
 pursuant to repealed Section 50-120 of Title 11 of the Oklahoma
 Statutes, after June 30, 2008, shall be offset by the increase in
 benefits, if any, provided by this section.

5 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104K of Title 20, unless there 7 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 Any person receiving benefits from the Uniform Retirement System 9 for Justices and Judges as of June 30, 2014, who continues to 10 receive benefits on or after July 1, 2015, shall receive a two-11 percent increase in said benefits beginning in July 2015.

12 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-305.12 of Title 47, unless 14 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, any
person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Law Enforcement
Retirement System as of June 30, 2014, who continues to receive
benefits on or after July 1, 2015, shall receive a two-percent
increase in said benefits beginning in July 2015.

B. Any increase in benefits a person is eligible to receive
pursuant to subsection B, C or D of Section 2-305 of Title 47 of the
Oklahoma Statutes, after June 30, 2015, shall be offset by the
increase in benefits, if any, provided by this section.

SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 17-116.22 of Title 70, unless
 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Any person receiving benefits from the Teachers' Retirement
System of Oklahoma as of June 30, 2014, other than those benefits
specified in subsection B of this section, who continues to receive
benefits on or after July 1, 2015, shall receive a two-percent
increase in said benefits beginning in July 2015.

B. Any person receiving benefits pursuant to subsection (3) of
Section 17-105 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes whose benefits
commenced prior to July 1, 2014, and who continues to receive
benefits on or after July 1, 2015, shall receive a two-percent
increase in said benefits beginning in July 2015.

SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 930.11 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person receiving benefits from the Oklahoma Public Employees
Retirement System as of June 30, 2014, who continues to receive
benefits on or after July 1, 2015, shall receive a two-percent
increase in said benefits beginning in July 2015.

SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2015.
SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
