AMENDATORY 29 O.S. 2011, Section 7-205, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 286, O.S.L. 2013 (29 O.S. Supp. 2015, 17 18 Section 7-205), is amended to read as follows: 19 Section 7-205. A. Excluding furbearers and coyotes, no person 20 may capture, kill, mutilate or destroy any wildlife protected by law 21 and remove the head, claws, teeth, hide, antlers, horns or any or 22 all of such parts from the body with the intent to abandon the body. 23 B. Excluding furbearers and coyotes, no person may capture or 24

mutilate any living wildlife protected by law by removing the claws,

teeth, hide, antlers, horns or any or all of such parts from the body.

- C. No person may kill any wildlife protected by law and abandon the body without disposing of the body in the most appropriate manner Except as otherwise provided for in this subsection, it shall be unlawful for any person through wanton disregard, carelessness or neglect to cause or allow any edible meat of a game bird, game mammal or game fish to go to waste. The provision of this subsection shall not apply if the meat is not fit for human consumption due to gunshot, injury or disease or if the wildlife specimen is being prepared for taxidermy.
- D. B. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this section shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one (1) year, or by both fine and imprisonment.
- E. C. Any hunting or fishing license issued to a <u>any</u> person by the Department of Wildlife Conservation shall be automatically revoked upon conviction of the <u>that</u> person of <u>for</u> violating the <u>provisions</u> any provision of this section. The revocation shall be for a period set by the court of not less than one (1) year nor more than ten (10) years. If the court does not set a period, the revocation shall be for one (1) year from the date of the conviction. During this period of the revocation period, the

- 1 Department shall not issue the person a hunting or fishing license.
- 2 | If the court does not set a revocation period, the Department shall
- 3 | not issue that person a license within one (1) year of the
- 4 | conviction of the person pursuant to this section. A person who has
- 5 | a license or permit revoked pursuant to this section shall surrender
- 6 | the revoked license or permit to the court. The court shall send
- 7 | the Department of Wildlife Conservation the revoked license and a
- 8 copy of the judgment of conviction. For purposes of this section,
- 9 "conviction" shall include a plea of guilty or nolo contendere to an

- D. For purposes of this section:
- 12 | 1. "Game bird" means all species of brant, cranes, doves,
- 13 ducks, gallinules, geese, grouse, partridge, pheasant, quail,
- 14 prairie chickens, rails, snipes, swans, wild turkey and woodcock;
- 15 | 2. "Game mammal" means deer, elk, bear, bighorn sheep,
- 16 | antelope, cottontail rabbit, swamp rabbit and squirrel;
- 3. "Game fish" means largemouth bass, smallmouth bass, white
- 18 bass, spotted bass, black crappie, white crappie, northern pike,
- 19 trout, sauger, saugeye, striped bass, hybrid striped bass, walleye,
- 20 paddlefish, blue catfish, flathead catfish and channel catfish;
 - 4. "Edible meat of a game bird" means the breast meat;
- 5. "Edible meat of a game mammal" means the four quarters and
- 23 loins or backstrap; and

6. "Edible meat of a game fish" means the two fillets.
