An Act relating to public finance; requiring payment to certain state or local government entities using government entity name; prohibiting use of state or local government officeholder for purposes of certain payment; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Public finance

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9001 of Title 62, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any person, firm, partnership, corporation, limited partnership, limited liability company or other lawfully recognized entity that is required to make payment of a tax, fee, fine, charge, cost or other expense payable to a state governmental entity or local governmental entity shall make the instrument payable to the state or local government office, agency or other governmental entity and shall not make the instrument payable to the individual who holds the public office.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
