13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.70.1 of Title 62, unless
16	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. It shall be unlawful for any state agency to make payroll
18	deductions on behalf of a state employee for membership dues in any
19	public employee association or organization or professional
20	organization that on or after November 1, 2015, collectively
21	bargains on behalf of its membership pursuant to any provision of
22	federal law.
23	B. For purposes of this section:
24	

1. "State agency" means any office, officer, bureau, board, 1 2 counsel, court, commission, institution, unit, division, body or house of the executive or judicial branches of the state government, 3 4 whether elected or appointed, excluding political subdivisions of 5 the state. State agency shall include public school districts, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the institutions, 6 7 centers, or other constituent agencies of The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education, the State Board of Career and Technology 8 9 Education, technology center school districts, the State 10 Legislature, and the office of the Governor; and 11 2. "Public employee" means an elected or appointed officer or 12 employee or contract employee of a state agency as defined in this 13 section, unless otherwise indicated. 14 SECTION 2.
