6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to payroll deductions; criminalizing
8 certain payroll deductions by state agencies;
9 defining terms; providing for codification; and
10 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 34.70.1 of Title 62, unless
15 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. It shall be unlawful for any state agency to make payroll
17 deductions on behalf of a state employee for membership dues in any
18 public employee association or organization or professional
19 organization that collectively bargains on behalf of its membership
20 pursuant to any provision of federal law.

21 B. For purposes of this section:

22 1. "State agency" means any office, officer, bureau, board,
23 counsel, court, commission, institution, unit, division, body or
24 house of the executive or judicial branches of the state government,

1 whether elected or appointed, excluding political subdivisions of
2 the state. State agency shall include public school districts, the
3 Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, the institutions,
4 centers, or other constituent agencies of The Oklahoma State System
5 of Higher Education, the State Board of Career and Technology
6 Education, technology center school districts, the State
7 Legislature, and the office of the Governor; and

8 2. "Public employee" means an elected or appointed officer or
9 employee or contract employee of a state agency as defined in this
10 section, unless otherwise indicated.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
