18	establish $\frac{1}{2}$ special use $\frac{1}{2}$ permits to be designated the:
19	1. "Annual Wildlife Conservation Passport"; and
20	2. "Three-Day Wildlife Conservation Passport".

22	exempt as provided for in subsection C of this section, who enter or

B. The Commission may establish and assess an annual:

- $\underline{1.}$ A fee of not more than One Dollar (\$1.00) above the cost of an annual resident hunting or fishing license for the $\underline{\text{Annual}}$ Wildlife Conservation Passport; and
- 2. A fee of not more than Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for the Three-Day Wildlife Conservation Passport.

Each person, not otherwise exempt as provided for in subsection C of this section, entering or using a designated area of land shall be required to have a Passport in their possession while in the area.

- C. The following persons shall be exempt from the Passport requirements of this section:
- 1. All persons who possess a valid Oklahoma annual fishing,

 hunting or combination resident fishing or hunting license, an

 annual nonresident fishing or hunting license, a lifetime resident

 or nonresident fishing, hunting, or combination license, a senior

 citizen lifetime fishing or hunting license, or a disability fishing

 or hunting license;
- 2. Legal residents of Oklahoma who are Persons under eighteen

 (18) sixteen (16) years of age on the first day of the current

 calendar year; and
- 3. Students and instructors participating in bona fide educational tours or activities sponsored or organized by an educational institution or entity or any other organized event

sanctioned in advance by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife

Conservation. Sponsors of such activities shall provide notice of

the date and number of persons participating in the activity to the

Department of Wildlife Conservation for approval not less than

twenty (20) days prior to the date of the activity.

- D. 1. Any person arrested while violating the provisions of this section may purchase a temporary thirty-day license from the arresting game warden in lieu of posting bond. The fee for a substitute license purchased pursuant to the provisions of this subsection shall be:
 - <u>a.</u> <u>Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for legal residents of this</u> state, and
 - <u>b.</u> <u>Ninety Dollars (\$90.00) for nonresidents.</u>
- 2. The fees from licenses purchased pursuant to the provisions of this subsection shall be deposited in the Wildlife Conservation

 Fund to be used exclusively for developing, managing, preserving and protecting wildlife and wildlife habitat.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2015.
