An Act relating to children; allowing safety plan monitor of a child in a safety plan to consent to certain examinations of the child; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Children

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-3-104 of Title 10A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The safety plan monitor of a child who is in a safety plan with the Department of Human Services may, if the parent of the child is unavailable, authorize medical or dental treatment or examinations which are necessary for the well-being of the child.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
