10 An Act relating to children; allowing safety plan
11 monitor of a child in a safety plan to consent to
12 certain examinations of the child; providing for
13 codification; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-3-104 of Title 10A, unless
17 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

18 The safety plan monitor of a child who is in a safety plan with
19 the Department of Human Services may, if the parent of the child is
20 unavailable, authorize medical or dental treatment or examinations
21 which are necessary for the wellbeing of the child.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
