7 An Act relating to state government; requiring
8 certain reports to be published on website of the
9 Oklahoma Secretary of State; prescribing procedures
10 with respect to omitted or redacted information;
11 prescribing procedures for providing exceptions;
12 requiring official designation of website or link;
13 providing for codification; and providing an
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 664.101 of Title 74, unless
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. Except as otherwise provided by this section, any report
20 required or authorized by law to be filed with the Governor, the
21 Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives or the President
22 Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, separately or in any
23 combination, shall be published, in full, on the website maintained
24 by or on behalf of the Secretary of State.

B. Any information contained in reports as described by
subsection A of this section required to be kept confidential shall

1 be excluded or redacted from the version of the report published on
2 the website. The entity transmitting a report which has information
3 that needs to be excluded or redacted shall include in the
4 transmittal document or email an identification of such material,
5 such as an appendix, an exhibit or other information. The Secretary
6 of State shall be responsible for identification of omitted or
7 redacted information and for establishing a consistent and reliable
8 method for modifying reports to avoid prohibited disclosure. The
9 Secretary of State shall clearly identify such reports on its
10 website as containing information omitted or redacted. The website
11 maintained by the Secretary of State or the link to the reports
12 shall be officially designated as the "Oklahoma Reporting
13 Transparency Portal".

14 C. The Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of
15 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State
16 Senate shall transmit any report received by any of their respective
17 offices, or a copy of such report, not later than thirty (30) days
18 after its receipt.

19 D. For reports required to be filed with any combination of the
20 Governor, the Speaker and the President Pro Tempore, the respective
21 officers shall coordinate the transmission of a report so that only
22 one copy of the report is transmitted to the Secretary of State.
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1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
