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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 664.101 of Title 74, unless
19	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	A. Except as otherwise provided by this section, any report
21	required or authorized by law to be filed with the Governor, the
22	Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives or the President
23	Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, separately or in any
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combination, shall be published, in full, on the website maintained
by or on behalf of the Secretary of State.

Any information contained in reports as described by 3 Β. 4 subsection A of this section required to be kept confidential shall 5 be excluded or redacted from the version of the report published on the website. The entity transmitting a report which has information 6 7 that needs to be excluded or redacted shall include in the transmittal document or email an identification of such material, 8 9 such as an appendix, an exhibit or other information. The Secretary 10 of State shall be responsible for identification of omitted or 11 redacted information and for establishing a consistent and reliable 12 method for modifying reports to avoid prohibited disclosure. The 13 Secretary of State shall clearly identify such reports on its 14 website as containing information omitted or redacted. The website 15 maintained by the Secretary of State or the link to the reports 16 shall be officially designated as the "Oklahoma Reporting 17 Transparency Portal".

18 C. The Governor, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of 19 Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State 20 Senate shall transmit any report received by any of their respective 21 offices, or a copy of such report, not later than thirty (30) days 22 after its receipt.

D. For reports required to be filed with any combination of the
Governor, the Speaker and the President Pro Tempore, the respective

1	officers shall coordinate the transmission of a report so that only
2	one copy of the report is transmitted to the Secretary of State.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
