17	As used in this section, "nitrous oxide" means any of the
18	following substances: N20, dinitrogen monoxide, dinitrogen oxide,
19	nitrogen oxide, or laughing gas.
20	1. No person, corporation, partnership, limited liability
21	company, firm, or any other business entity doing business in this
22	state shall sell or offer for sale nitrous oxide to any person under
23	the age of twenty-one (21).

- 2. Any person, corporation, partnership, limited liability company, firm, or any other business entity doing business in this state selling, offering for sale, or distributing nitrous oxide shall require proof of legal age prior to allowing an individual to purchase or receive a shipment of nitrous oxide. Identification is not required of any individual who reasonably appears to be at least twenty-five (25) years of age. An individual's appearance shall not constitute a defense in any proceeding alleging the sale or distribution of nitrous oxide to an individual under the age of twenty-one (21) years old.
- 3. Any person, corporation, partnership, limited liability company, firm, or any other business entity doing business in this state who violates this section of law shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction shall be subject to imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one (1) year or a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), or both such imprisonment and fine.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2025.
