17	A. As used in this section:
18	1. "Private school student" means any student who is enrolled
19	in a private school or receiving education by other means pursuant
20	to Section 10-105 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and
21	2. "Part-time basis" means a student who is enrolled in one or
22	more courses, services, or activities of a public school on a less
23	than full-time basis.

- B. The board of education of a school district shall permit, in the same manner as public school students pursuant to Section 1-114 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, the enrollment of a private school student on a part-time basis. Preference shall be given to part-time students who are otherwise eligible for full-time enrollment in the school district due to residency requirements.
- C. The State Board of Education may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
