6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to poor persons; providing directive  
8 to the Department of Human Services to modify child  
9 care subsidies; providing for codification; and  
10 providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 230.71 of Title 56, unless there  
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 The Department of Human Services shall promulgate rules to  
16 modify the "Child Care Eligibility/Co-payment Chart" by increasing  
17 income eligibility limits and establishing a new copayment structure  
18 in a manner that will result in a longer-term phaseout of  
19 eligibility, so that increases in family income in low-income  
20 families will not result in the loss of the benefit and in a manner  
21 that will be revenue neutral for the Department.

22 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2017.
