6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to schools; creating the Healthy
8 Eating and Physical Activity Act; requiring after-
9 school and summer programs to adopt healthy eating
10 standards and promote physical activity; establishing
11 training and policies for program personnel;
12 directing compliance with national nutrition
13 standards; prohibiting certain beverages; providing
14 opportunities for physical activities; setting limits
15 on screen time; providing for codification; and
16 providing an effective date.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

18 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
19 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100e of Title 70, unless
20 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

21 A. This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Healthy
22 Eating and Physical Activity Act".

23 B. School-based, after-school and summer programs, including,
24 but not limited to, the State Department of Education's Oklahoma
21st Century Community Learning Centers, which provide expanded

1 learning opportunities for students shall adopt healthy eating
2 standards and promote physical activity in their curriculums.

3 C. The programs shall:

4 1. Promote proper nutrition and developmentally appropriate
5 practices by establishing training and policies for program
6 personnel;

7 2. Comply with the United States Food and Drug Administration's
8 Child and Adult Care Food Program nutrition standards for food and
9 beverages served to children;

10 3. Prohibit beverages that contain added sweeteners or
11 caffeine;

12 4. Provide opportunities for developmentally appropriate,
13 inclusive moderate and vigorous physical activities, games and
14 sports; and

15 5. Set limits on screen time to ensure that digital devices are
16 used for homework, research or digital learning that is active
17 rather than passive.

18 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
