Thousand Dollars (\$20,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

- 2. Any person who violates the provisions of this section where the victim of the offense is under eighteen (18) years of age at the time of the offense shall, upon conviction, be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term of not less than nine (9) years or for life, or by a fine not exceeding Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.
- 3. The terms of imprisonment specified in this subsection shall not be subject to statutory provisions for suspension, deferral or probation or state correctional institution earned credits accruing from and after November 1, 1989, except for the achievement earned credits authorized by subsection H of Section 138 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes. To qualify for such achievement earned credits, such inmates must also be in compliance with the standards for Class level 2 behavior, as defined in subsection D of Section 138 of Title 57 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- 4. Upon a second or subsequent conviction, the person shall be required to register as a sex offender under the Sex Offenders

 Registration Act and shall be assigned a risk level of one. Upon a
