12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 5 O.S. 2011, Section 12, is
14 amended to read as follows:

15 Section 12. The Supreme Court of the State of Oklahoma shall
16 have exclusive power and authority to pass upon qualifications and
17 fitness of all applicants for admission to practice law in ~~the State~~
18 ~~of Oklahoma~~ this state, and the qualifications of such applicants
19 shall be those which are now or may be hereafter prescribed by the
20 statutes of Oklahoma and the rules of the Supreme Court including,
21 but not limited to, requiring a national criminal history record
22 check as defined by Section 150.9 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma
23 Statutes on applicants.
