6	AS INTRODUCED
7	An Act relating to transportation; creating the Oklahoma Council on Access to Transportation; stating
8	duties of the Council; specifying the composition of members of the Council; requiring membership of
9	certain state officials; requiring Council to create Advisory Committee; stating terms to be served by
10	Advisory Committee appointees; specifying certain individuals for Advisory Committee; allowing Council
11	to determine meeting times and places; stating members shall serve without compensation; providing
12	for certain reimbursement; directing certain administrative support; stating certain
13	administrative support duties; requiring election of chair and vice-chair; requiring certain annual report
14	to the Governor; allowing existing members of Council and Advisory Committee to serve out current terms
15	assigned; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4020 of Title 69, unless there
21	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
22	A. There is hereby created the Oklahoma Council on Access to
23	Transportation.
24	B. The Oklahoma Council on Access to Transportation shall:

- 1. Provide a comprehensive assessment of passenger

 2 transportation services in Oklahoma in order to maximize

 3 availability, efficiency and quality services. State agencies that

 4 provide passenger transportation services shall be included in the

 5 assessment. All state agencies shall cooperate with the Council in

 6 implementing its recommendations;
 - 2. Review interagency agreements regarding such services and recommend the consolidation or restructuring of inefficient or duplicative programs;
 - 3. Evaluate existing state and federal funding programs and other resources;
 - 4. Identify and devise pragmatic means to eliminate service gaps and barriers to access; and
 - 5. Develop recommendations to improve coordination among passenger transportation providers.
 - C. The Council shall be composed of the following state officials or their designees:
 - 1. Director of the Oklahoma Department of Commerce;
- 20 Services;
 - 3. State Commissioner of Health;

- 4. Director of the Oklahoma Department of Human Services;
- 5. Commissioner of the Oklahoma Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services;

- 1 6. Director of the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs;
- 7. Director of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation;
 - 8. Director of the Oklahoma Office of Disability Concerns;
 - 9. Chief Executive Officer of the Oklahoma Health Care

- 10. Oklahoma Native American Liaison;
 - 11. Director of the Oklahoma Employment Security Commission;
 - 12. State Superintendent of Public Instruction; and
 - 13. Office of the Governor designee.
- D. The Council shall appoint an Advisory Committee to assist
- 11 | the Council in evaluating Oklahoma's passenger transportation
- 12 | services and in formulating recommendations for their improvement.
- 13 | These members shall serve the Council for a three-year term
- 14 beginning upon appointment and may be reappointed at the discretion
- 15 of the Council. Each Advisory Committee member shall continue to
- 16 | serve until a new appointment has been made for his or her position.
- 17 The Advisory Committee shall be composed of the following
- 18 | individuals:
- 19 1. Two members representing the transportation-disadvantaged;
- 20 2. Three members representing transportation providers;
- 3. Two members representing transportation-disadvantaged
- 22 organizations; and
- 4. Three members representing community government
- 24 organizations.

The Council shall meet at such times and places as it deems appropriate. Council and Advisory Committee members shall serve without compensation. Council members employed by a state agency shall be reimbursed for travel expenses related to their service on the Council as authorized by the State Travel Reimbursement Act. Remaining Council and Advisory Committee members shall be reimbursed for travel expenses related to their service as authorized by the Oklahoma Department of Rehabilitation Services and in accordance with the State Travel Reimbursement Act. Administrative support for the Council, including, but not limited to, personnel necessary to ensure the proper performance of the duties and responsibilities of the Council and Advisory Committee and the design and maintenance of the Council's MyRide Mobility application, shall be provided by the Oklahoma Department of Rehabilitation Services. The Council shall elect a chair and vice-chair from its membership. The Council shall report to the Governor regarding its progress and status on January 1, 2020, and annually thereafter.

F. Current membership of the Council and Advisory Committee shall not be affected upon the effective date of this act. Existing members of the Council and Advisory Committee shall continue to serve out their terms as previously prescribed by Executive Order.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
