6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;
8 providing for the deduction of credits for inmates
9 who served in the Armed Forces; prohibiting the
10 Department of Corrections from revoking awarded
11 credits; providing for codification; and providing an
12 effective date.

13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

14 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 138.2 of Title 57, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 Every inmate of a state correctional facility who was honorably
18 discharged from active service in any branch of the Armed Forces of
19 the United States or the Oklahoma National Guard shall be entitled
20 to a deduction of no more than one hundred (100) credits for his or
21 her military service. The Department of Corrections shall not have
22 the authority to revoke such credits awarded to an inmate.

23 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.
