11 An Act relating to the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River
12 Navigation System (MKARNS); creating the McClellan-
13 Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System Infrastructure
14 Revolving Fund; providing for authorized sources of
15 revenue; providing for expenditure of funds and
16 prescribing procedures related thereto; providing for
17 codification; providing an effective date; and
18 declaring an emergency.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

20 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1141 of Title 82, unless there
22 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
24 for the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to be designated the
"McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System Infrastructure

1 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
2 to fiscal year limitations, for the purpose of pooling all monies
3 received by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation from
4 appropriations, dedicated revenues, federal funds, private
5 contributions or other sources authorized by law. All monies
6 accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may
7 be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of
8 Transportation upon a recommendation by the ODOT Waterways Advisory
9 Board for the purpose of repairing or constructing assets which are
10 part of the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System (MKARNS)
11 located in the State of Oklahoma which are essential to the safe and
12 efficient operation of such system. Expenditures from said fund
13 shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against
14 claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
15 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

16 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

17 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
18 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
19 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
20 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
