18 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Page 1, strike the title, enacting clause and
19 entire bill and insert

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21 "An Act relating to the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River
22 Navigation System (MKARNS); creating the McClellan-
23 Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System Infrastructure
24 Revolving Fund; providing for authorized sources of
revenue; providing for expenditure of funds and
prescribing procedures related thereto; providing for
codification; providing an effective date; and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1141 of Title 82, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
2 for the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to be designated the
3 "McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System Infrastructure
4 Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject
5 to fiscal year limitations, for the purpose of pooling all monies
6 received by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation from
7 appropriations, dedicated revenues, federal funds, private
8 contributions or other sources authorized by law dedicated to the
9 McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System (MKARNS). All
10 monies accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated
11 and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma Department of
12 Transportation upon a recommendation by the Waterways Advisory Board
13 of the Oklahoma Department of Transportation and upon consultation
14 with all Native American tribes with an ownership interest in the
15 Arkansas riverbed for the purpose of repairing or constructing
16 assets which are part of the MKARNS located in the State of Oklahoma
17 which are essential to the safe and efficient operation of such
18 system and may also be used to match federal grants and awards
19 associated with channel improvements of the MKARNS, whether due to
20 natural disasters, emergency conditions, operations and maintenance
21 needs or construction projects. Expenditures from the fund shall be
22 made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims
23 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of the Office of
24 Management and Enterprise Services for approval and payment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
